Andy Selby is a Grammy award winning musician/engineer/producer living in Franklin, TN. His musical training began at an early age with piano lessons, continuing through high school where he gained a significant knowledge of theory and composition. Choosing to attend a local community college (American River College) in Sacramento, CA, he spent several years under the direction and teaching of several nationally respected professors. He finished his career there with two years of student directing both the Chamber and Jazz choirs, which honed his ear for vocals and and ensemble directing. During these years Andy also realized his passion for music technology, teaching himself from the very early days and instructing others along the way.

Andy left California in 1993 with his wife, Debi, and moved to Nashville, TN to take part in the exploding Christian music scene. He has since branched into all musical genres, utilizing a deep skill set and enjoying fruitful relationships. He started in his early days as a programmer and engineer for Word Publishing, continuing to today with a long list of artists and producers. In 2006, Andy received a Grammy for his work on CeCe Winans "Purified" album, producing the song "You Are Loved" and working on several other songs with producer Tommy Sims (co-writer of the song "Change The World", sung by Eric Clapton and produced by Babyface.) He won his second Grammy in 2009 for his work, again with Tommy, on another CeCe Winans album, "Thy Kingdom Come". The list of artists he has worked with also includes Mat Kearney, The Canadian Tenors, Karmin, Echosmith, TobyMac, Hot Chelle Rae, Adam Lambert, and Cody Karey, just to name a few.

In 2006, Andy, along with co writers Jeff Cohen and Michael Ochs, had a song recorded by Josh Groban on his album "Awake". The song "In Her Eyes" is a fan favorite at live performances, and the album sold upwards of 4 million copies worldwide.

Today he continues to work in both studios and with his cherished mobile rig. He is most well known for his vocal editing skills, synth/string/drum programming, and mixing abilities.
